Day 1 is open to sector professionals and provides a foundational understanding of dissociation and its clinical management.

Day 1 Segments:

- Recognising Dissociation
- Fraser's Table I (with demonstration or video)
- EMDR and Trauma-Related Dissociation
- Memory Processing Demonstration or video with Emotional Parts

Day 2 is for those who have completed EMDR Singaporeapproved Basic Training. It focuses on advanced strategies for treating highly dissociative clients and is recommended for experienced practitioners seeking further training in this area. Completion of Day 1 is required before attending Day 2.

Day 2 is a hands-on practicum. Trainees must be prepared to take on both clinician and client roles. As clinicians, they will apply lecture and video content—including Fraser's Table—and reprocess a memory with Emotional Parts. As clients, they must be willing to engage with their own Emotional Parts during practice.
